



## Deer Resistant Plants

Please keep in mind that the listed items are only suggested plantings to try to encourage deer to look elsewhere for food, however if an animal is starving, it is likely to eat just about anything. Normally deer avoid plants with strong taste or smell and those with "hairy" textured foliage. We have had very positive feedback in regards to the effectiveness of some deer repellent products such as Plantskydd and Deer Away.
